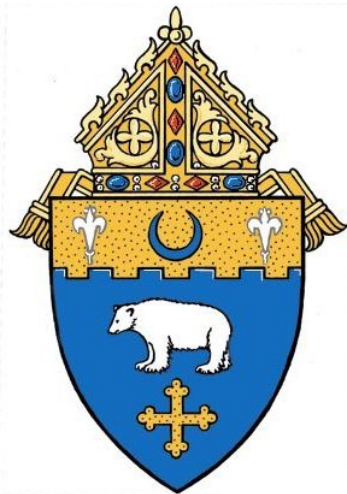

*The bear is from the seal of the state of Missouri.*

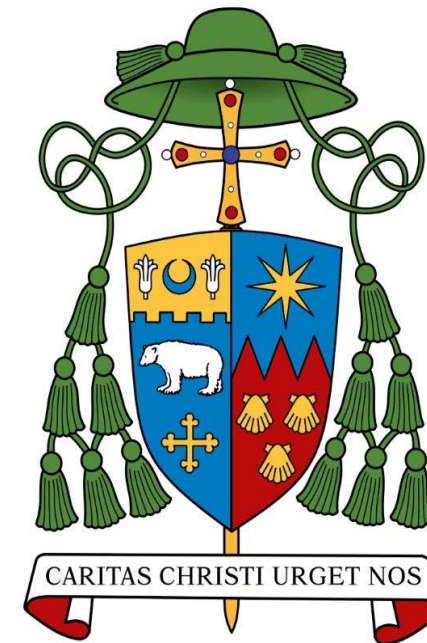

## THE RITE OF ELECTION / **Celebración de la Elección**

### Presentation of the Catechumens / **Presentación de los Catecúmenos**

*Deacon:* Would all of the Catechumens, all of you to be baptized, please stand. Bishop Johnston, Easter is drawing near ... Now they ask that after the celebration of the Scrutinies... participate in the Sacraments of Baptism, Confirmation, and the Eucharist.

*Bishop:* Catechumens, since you have already heard the call of Christ ...Do you wish to enter fully into the life of the Church through the Sacraments of Baptism, Confirmation, and Eucharist?

**Catechumens: We do!** (*Sí, queremos.*)

*Deacon:* Would the Godparents of the Catechumens please stand.

*Bishop:* Godparents, God's Holy Church wishes to know whether these Catechumens are sufficiently prepared to be enrolled among the Elect for the coming celebration of Easter. Have they faithfully listened to God's Word proclaimed by the Church?

**Godparents: They have!** (*Sí, lo han hecho.*)

*Bishop:* Have they responded to that word and begun to walk in God's Presence?

**Godparents: They have!** (*Sí, lo han hecho.*)

*Bishop:* Have they shared the company of their Christian brothers and sisters and joined them in prayer?

**Godparents: They have!** (*Sí, lo han hecho.*)

*Bishop:* And to all gathered in this assembly, are you ready to support ... and include them in your prayers and affection as they move towards Easter?

**ALL: We are!** (*Sí, lo estamos.*)

## RITE OF CALL TO CONTINUING CONVERSION **CELEBRACIÓN DE LLAMADO A LOS CANDIDATOS A LA CONVERSIÓN CONTINUA**

### Presentation of the Candidates / **Presentación de los Candidatos**

*Deacon:* Will the Candidates please stand.

Bishop Johnston, these Candidates, who stand before you, have already been baptized, but seek full communion with the Church... Now they ask for full initiation into the Church through the Sacraments of Confirmation and the Eucharist.



*Bishop:* Candidates, you have heard the call of Christ in your lives ...Do you wish to enter fully into the life of the Church through the Sacraments of Confirmation and Eucharist?

**Candidates: We do!** (*Sí, queremos.*)

*Bishop:* The Christian life and the demands that flow from the Sacraments ...that the Church hear the testimony of their sponsors about their readiness.

*Deacon:* Would the sponsors of these Candidates please stand.

*Bishop:* Sponsors, have they faithfully listened to God's Word proclaimed by the Church?

**Sponsors: They have!** (*Sí, lo han hecho.*)

*Bishop:* Have they come to a deeper appreciation of their baptism, in which they were joined to Christ and the Church?

**Sponsors: They have!** (*Sí, lo han hecho.*)

*Bishop:* Have they joined their sisters and brothers in communal prayer and service?

**Sponsors: They have!** (*Sí, lo han hecho.*)

*Bishop:* Have they reflected on the tradition of the Church which is their heritage, and contemplated the bright future of the Church in which they shall have a share?

**Sponsors: They have!** (*Sí, lo han hecho.*)

*Bishop:* And to all gathered in this assembly, are you ready to support the testimony expressed about these Candidates, and include them in your prayers and affection as we move toward Easter?

**ALL: We are!** (*Sí, lo estamos.*)

*Bishop:* Let the Candidates and the Catechumens come forward, as the Catechumens inscribe their names in the Book of the Elect.

*The candidates and sponsors are seated. Los candidatos y padrinos se sientan.*
