



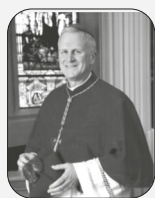

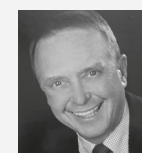

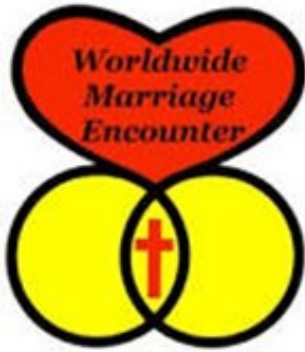
Closer to home, imagine a neighborhood where people got along, where diversity was treasured, and violence was no more. We all long for the security that comes from peace.

SUPPER TIME!

Yes, Morning Glory Ministries is now serving dinner, Monday-Friday 5:30-6:30.

When the pandemic closed restaurants in KC, **The Reiger** restaurant shut its doors on March 16 and that same afternoon made the announcement that they would become **Crossroads Community Kitchen** to serve meals at-the-door to those needing to be fed.

As our city has begun re-opening, **The Reiger** has started making plans to again serve their paying customers inside. But they still want to continue to serve free meals to the poor. As they were looking for a location to do this, Morning Glory stepped up. Since June 24th, employees at **The Reiger** have prepared and boxed dinners at their facility to bring to MGM where they distribute to any who need to eat, each Monday-Friday.



MGM also continues recently formed partnerships with Street Medicine KC (which is soon to move to their new location at 7th & Paseo but will still do outreach at MGM) and with Truman Medical Center Behavioral Health. Food, Mental Health, Medical Help, Clothing, Identification, Hygiene, and much more. Your small, parish social service ministry is really making a humongous positive impact for the less fortunate of Kansas City. Please continue to support MGM with prayer and financial giving.



PRAYERS FOR TAYLOR

Please pray for one of our daily guests, Taylor, who was brutally robbed, stabbed several times and left to die last Thursday night. Taylor was rushed to Truman Medical Center where he received excellent care which saved his life. He is now beginning recovery. I was able to call Taylor on Monday and asked what he needed. He said he was sorry that the thieves took the rosary MGM had given him, could he have another. Within the hour, Fr. Paul and I were with Taylor at the hospital. Though his parents are deceased and he has no family, he is proud of his Catholic upbringing. MGM has helped Taylor get back on track over the past three months and he most recently was awarded a housing voucher, on track to get a roof over his head within the next couple weeks. Pray for his recovery and for all who live on the violent streets of KC.
