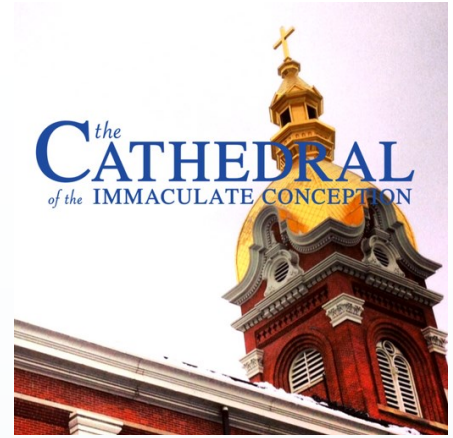

After reporting to these civil and law enforcement authorities, report suspected *sexual abuse of a minor or vulnerable adult* to the Diocesan Ombudsman, Joe Crayon, at 816.812.2500 or crayon@ombudsmankcsj.org, if the abuse involves a priest, deacon, employee or volunteer of the Diocese of Kansas City-St. Joseph.

Knowing What Is Right



The beginning of wisdom is its absence.

When we reach inside ourselves and realize what we do not have, we start the journey to attain what we need.

When we speak about someone having “the wisdom of Solomon,” we mean he or she is wise beyond measure. Solomon won that wisdom by first acknowledging he was not smart enough to do the job God had given him to do.

Solomon's father was David, the greatest of the kings. Solomon followed him while still a youth. He was placed in charge of numerous people. Solomon, not wishing to disappoint God, feared that he lacked the skills necessary for the task. So he asked God for wisdom to tell right from wrong.

Another leader would have asked for a long life and personal gain, or for riches and personal pleasure, or for the death of enemies and the removal of fear. But Solomon realized he needed something much more practical for the people he was to lead: the wisdom to know right from wrong.

When we face a decision, the first step may be to acknowledge we do not know the answer. We ask God not for personal gain, but for the gift of knowing what is the right thing to do. That will bring peace.

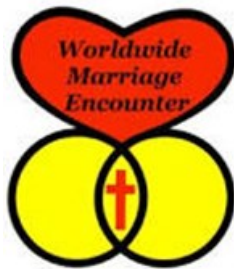

Happenings Throughout Diocese

Are you 70 and ½ or older? Do you want to save on federal and state income taxes?

Giving directly from your IRA to a qualified charity like the Cathedral of the Immaculate Conception, Annual Catholic Appeal, diocesan or parish ministry can be a tax-wise strategy. If you are a Senior required to take a Minimum Required Distribution from your IRA, you can transfer your contribution directly to the charity. This is called a Qualified Charitable Distribution and it reduces your income by the amount of your contribution. By reducing your income not one penny of your charitable contribution goes to taxes.

Are some of your shares of stock or mutual funds higher than when you bought them? This provides you a wise method of giving to Cathedral of the Immaculate Conception. Donating appreciated stock or mutual fund shares is a strategic gift-planning method. In most cases, the donor receives an itemized deduction in the full amount of the fair market value (FMV) of the shares donated as of the date of the gift.
