# What Am I Doing for Advent This Year?

Advent is a time of hope. It isn't Christmas, and it isn't "the holiday season." It is its own special time of preparation. This booklet will guide you through the busiest season of the year as you await the coming of Christ.

## First Sunday of Advent

1 Corinthians 1:3-9

#### Ready or Not

When a new child is born, parents are excited. But they also wonder, "Am I ready for this?" Parenting carries responsibilities. A new child will cause unimaginable changes. There is never enough preparation for parenting. Eventually a parent realizes, "I'm as ready as I'll ever be." God usually provides them with the grace, wisdom, and patience they seek. All the spiritual gifts they want are there.

The Christian community at Corinth was like a young family with new children. Having received the gift of faith, this community shared their determination to forge a way of life in union with the Gospel of Jesus

Christ. It was an exciting time but also a nervous time. They probably wondered, "Am I ready for this?"

They believed that the Second Coming of Christ was imminent. They believed they had to prepare each day to meet Christ whenever he returned. Most important, as they thought about the end, the day of their Lord Jesus Christ, they wondered, "Am I ready for this?"

Paul told them yes. "You are not lacking in any spiritual gift as you wait for the revelation of our Lord Jesus Christ."

And neither are we. As we begin this Advent, filled with excitement and nervous about the weeks ahead, it is natural to wonder, "Am I ready?" You are not lacking in any spiritual gift. Open your arms and welcome Christ!



#### **Bunching Donations**

The new tax law increases the standard deduction. The increased standard deduction may limit the usage of charitable contributions as itemized deductions. You might consider bunching charitable deductions to get a bigger itemized deduction and lower taxes. Example, instead of giving \$5000 per year, give \$10,000 every other year. A tool that can be used to assist with bunching charitable deductions is a donor-advised fund (DAF). You put several years of donations into the DAF and get the full deduction, but distribute the funds to the Cathedral over time. Most investment firms offer DAF and they are relatively easy to get set up. Please consult you financial or tax adviser

### Are you 70 and ½ or older? Do you want to save on federal and state income taxes?

Giving directly from your IRA to a qualified charity like the Cathedral of the Immaculate Conception, Annual Catholic Appeal, diocesan or parish ministry can be a tax-wise strategy. If you are a Senior required to take a Minimum Required Distribution from your IRA, you can transfer your contribution directly to the charity. This is called a Qualified Charitable Distribution and it reduces your income by the amount of your contribution. By reducing your income not one penny of your

charitable contribution goes to taxes.
