1 John 5:1–9

Testimony in Water and Blood

If your organization hires a guest speaker, someone usually gives an introduction.



You'll hear who the speaker is, as well as his or her accomplishments. Guest speakers have overcome some obstacles: They have graduated from school. They have written papers. They have generated new and successful ideas. They have influenced other people. They have faced opposition and continued steadfast in their belief. Some of them have had conversions. Some of them have shed blood. Before they stand up and speak, you hear an introduction, a testimony that bears witness.

The First Letter of John gives that kind of testimony about Jesus Christ. It calls him "the one who came through water and blood." John does not speak on his own: "The Spirit is the one who testifies, and the Spirit is truth. So there are three that testify, the Spirit, the water, and the blood, and the three are of one accord." At his baptism, Jesus was announced as the Son of God. On the cross, his body was pierced with a lance, and water and blood poured out. At his baptism and at his death, in water and in blood, the Spirit bore witness that Jesus is the Son of God.

As we celebrate the Baptism of the Lord, we hear the testimony about Jesus. And we receive the challenge to add our voice to those of ages past. Jesus is the Son of God.

FROZEN TO DEATH

This week in Kansas City two people froze to death. Scott "Sixx" has been a frequent guest at MGM for at least as long as I've been the director. His aunt came by Tuesday; she wanted to see the places where Scott received services. At first I said I didn't know "Sixx", but then she described him and his dog Debo; and it struck me. I just didn't know his name on the street.

Scott was a strong, confident man, and not one whom I thought would end up dying on the streets. Lord, help us reach more of our struggling brothers

and sisters, thank you for letting us be your hands and feet to the marginalized.

Thank you so much to all who were able to make special year-end gifts to Morning Glory. In the last two weeks of December we received a gift honoring Sr. Loretto Marie for \$19,250, another for \$10,000, another for \$2,500, another for \$2,200, three for \$1,000, several for between \$50 and \$1,000, \$1,000 in gifts from the Chris & Kelly Angles wedding, and from the Helen Kretzer Schutte Homelessness Fund a grant award check for \$20,579. The generosity is astounding and the support shown for our mission truly inspiring.

All donations to MGM are received with the great gratitude of our staff and the guests whom we serve. Of course our ministry relies on donations to remain open and serving and paying our small staff. We could not do what we do without you, without our parish and diocese, and without the support of our partner agencies.

Because of such generosity, we have the freedom to adapt to the changing needs of our guests. Larry is a disabled, homeless veteran, he does own a 22-year-old van that sometimes he sleeps in. Just before Christmas the van was broken into and ransacked. Though he thankfully did not lose many items, the window of his van was broken. Replacing windows is not something MGM typically does, but because of our generous donors, we were happy to be able to pay for this expense. And over the past week, we also paid apartment deposits for two homeless families, from funds given for this specific purpose. TOGETHER WE ARE ALL MAKING A BIG DIFFERENCE!
