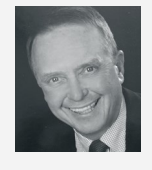

or crayon@ombudsmankcsj.org, if the abuse involves a priest, deacon, employee or volunteer of the Diocese of Kansas City-St. Joseph.

Ezekiel 37:12-14

A Change of Heart

Are you still being faithful to your Lenten resolutions? No matter how firm or weak your resolve, you have come to face the mystery of sin, loss, and death. Changing old habits is hard. To change something is to lose something.

Those chosen for Baptism this Easter will change their old habits. They will put to death whatever has kept them from life in Christ. The faithful also will change old habits. They will put to death the sin that mars their faithfulness to God. All in the community need the prayerful and penitential support of their brothers and sisters in Christ.

Ezekiel addresses people who have lived in exile and oppression, far from the center of their social and religious life. They have lived in a tomb. Now God promises, "I will open your graves and have you rise from them." God will dwell with them and give them the divine spirit.

This Lent, the church has invited you to examine your life, to confront your sin, and to secure your intent to change. The season is nearly over. The day of promise draws near. God stands ready to open your grave and bring you forth to new life. If you die to whatever keeps you from God, you will grow from the lessons of loss.

A NEW HOME BY EASTER?

Meet John. John is 79 years old. He uses a walker due to back and knee pain, he also is almost totally blind, can only hear loud voices, often forgets what day it is, and can be rather disorganized.

John also makes me laugh every day, he is kind, humble, shy, and spiritual. His immediate family has all passed; a nephew and niece survive, but he hasn't seen them in 30 years.

John told me he has lived in his apartment since 1984; he likes it because it is close to the Cathedral and his favorite



place, Morning Glory Ministries. John has never been late on his rent, even though his only income is his small social security pension.

John's last day to live at the apartment is March 31. He doesn't want to leave, but his lease "is not being renewed". I spoke to the complex and was told nicely that the attorneys approved not renewing his lease. As of March 31, this sweet old man will be living on the streets of Kansas City.

But not if we can help it: MGM helped get John's documents in order and worked with Street Medicine KC to get a primary care doctor (John hasn't seen a doctor in over 20 years). And now our agencies are in a mad scramble to find a place for John with some skilled nursing care, a subsidized place he can afford. All this takes time, and that is what we are short of. If time expires, we will move John's stuff into MGM and an extended stay hotel room until we find an apartment. This is the reality today in

Kansas City. --John Kraus, MGM Director
