### The Presence of God

Many believers can tell about a time they experienced the presence of God. It may have been at childbirth, after successful surgery, during a walk at the ocean, at the quiet dawn of a new day, or in the wisdom shared by a trusted friend. God appears to us in ways great and small.

One of the most dramatic stories of the presence of God concerns Moses. He heard God speak on Mount Sinai. God instructed him to tell the people, "If you hearken to my voice and keep my covenant, you shall be my special possession, dearer to me than all other people." So Moses descended the mountain, reported to the elders, and all the people responded together, "Everything the Lord has said, we will do."



A few days later they looked up. "There were peals of thunder and lightning, and a heavy cloud over the mountain, and a very loud trumpet blast." All the people trembled. Who wouldn't? Smoke rose from the top of Mount Sinai. The people stood below. Moses spoke to God, and God answered in thunder.

On Pentecost Sunday, the disciples of Jesus experienced God in tongues as of fire and a noise like a strong wind. As Moses received the law, so the disciples received the Holy Spirit.


Our experience of God may be dramatic or common. But it can always transform us, strengthen our belief, renew our covenant with God, and give us confidence to proclaim what we know: God is here.

### Thursday, May 26 Topic: Creating Married Home Life


