
Away from Home

Homesickness afflicts students away at school, workers on business trips and even families on vacation. It is exciting to travel, but going home is always the best part. Home is just that—a place we call our own, a place where we are most ourselves, a place of comfort, a center. It's pleasant to see something else, but after a while it's hard to be away.

Paul, the apostle, had ambivalent feelings about "home." He was a missionary, after all, so he spent a good part of his adult life traveling and taking up different residences thanks to the kindness of strangers. Paul thought more deeply about the meaning of *home*. For him, it was not just a place; it was the very body we inhabit. "We are at home in the body."

Even so, Paul was not at home with that home. At home in the body meant "we are away from the Lord" And for Paul, that was the real home.
