

Divine Role Model

Having a good role model helps. When we spot someone we admire, we can envision how to improve ourselves. A good role model can encourage



us and help us see not only our shortcomings but also our gifts. It helps to have attainable goals. Then as we advance along the path we have chosen, we feel better about our ability, our purpose, and the choice we have made for someone to admire.

Some role models waver and cause disillusionment. They set us back and fill our minds with questions about who we are, where we are going, and how we can get there.

Other role models set too high a standard for us. We would like to become like them, but we discover we don't have the mental, physical, or emotional agility to do what they do. That is discouraging too.

So it is with some apprehension that we hear the Letter to the Ephesians recommend a role model we all should follow: God. "Be imitators of God," it says. Well, that's not so easy. The letter asks us to remove "all bitterness, fury, anger, shouting and reviling, along with all

malice." That's not so easy either. It also says, "Be kind to one another, compassionate, and forgiving." Oh, my.

But Christ really is a good role model. "Christ loved us and handed himself over for us." Anyone should be able to do that if we put our minds to it: love and sacrifice.

SAVING KC

Last Friday we had KK from Care Beyond the Boulevard as well as staff from the Kansas City Health Department join us during breakfast and Emergency Assistance to pro-

vide a vaccination clinic. Twenty three more of our guests were vaccinated. All three COVID vaccines were given as well as the Hepatitis A vaccine. We've been promoting vaccinations for some time and are happy to report the vast majority of MGM guests have received the vaccine, exceeding the rate of the general citizenry. Our guests at MGM are doing their part to help keep Kanas City safe! A big Thank You to our homeless brothers and sisters.



8 LONG MONTHS

In December 2020, I helped Paul apply for his birth certificate from New Jersey. Without a birth certificate, there is no way to get a Missouri State ID.

The message on the phone at the New Jersey Dept. of Health simply states that because of COVID they are not taking phone calls. Their website doesn't help. Emails return a generic response. I left messages with everyone I could, even NJ state representatives. Eventually I received an email: the application is in process, that was back in early June.

Finally, last week, after 8 months Paul got his birth certificate. And now he has an ID. Luckily the employer that wanted to hire him still offered him a job. Now he can get on with his life. This was a difficult case b/c Paul was born in a military hospital in NJ on a base that has since been closed. But too often our homeless guests have seemingly insurmountable obstacles to overcome; we do our part to try to help.
