We have opportunities to care for the needy. Some organizations help them get back on their feet through food, loans, and job training. They rely on financial help, as well as the hours that volunteers give on site. From time to time churches take up collections to be sent abroad. In some cases, people blessed with resources have visited countries with a depressed economy, in order to understand the needs, meet the people, and advocate for assistance back home. On a national level, the budget of our country allocates some funds for foreign aid. But the totals are too often too small. Every citizen has the opportunity to influence the budget by contacting senators and representatives in congress.

The world has enough resources to end hunger and poverty. We lack only the resolve and the willingness to sacrifice.

The Letter of James says, "If a brother or sister has nothing to wear and has no food for the day, and one of you says to them, 'Go in peace, keep warm, and eat well,' but you do not give them the necessities of the body, what good is it?" Faith without works is dead.
