
# PROTECTING GOD'S CHILDREN TRAINING

Protecting God's Children for Adults is a program to ensure safe environments in all parishes, schools, and diocesan programs. The focus of this free training is to increase awareness about the nature of child sexual abuse. This is an awareness session, led by a trained facilitator, that includes videos and discussion. Participants learn the warning signs of abuse, strategies for handling suspicions of abuse, and ways to respond to abuse.

# Creating Life, Making Peace

Often the right person can make things happen. In the family, a business, a club, or a choir, the enthusiasm and expertise that one person brings can make all the parts work together. In some families, there is one person who gathers people together and who makes them laugh and cry, celebrate who they are, and tend to those less fortunate. In some businesses, there is one person with the right vision to fashion a project that

makes a real difference in peoples' lives. Even at



school, one person might give a class its character, a natural leader whose creativity brings life and whose compassion helps enemies make peace.

In some small way, those images explain the role of Christ in the universe. The Letter to the Colossians says he is "the firstborn of all creation" and "firstborn from the dead." "In him were created all things in heaven and on earth." He is the first to rise from the dead, "that in all things he himself might be preeminent." In these ways, Christ Jesus is the first of everything.

But Christ is also the unity of everything. Because he is the firstborn of all creation, "in him all things hold together." Because he is the firstborn from the dead, he reconciles all things, "making peace by the blood of his cross." We may strive to create life and to bring peace, but we do it as disciples of Christ.
