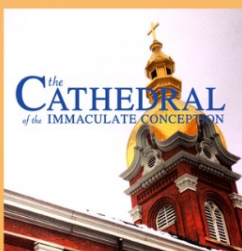
Let the blessing of God, first spoken to Moses, echoing throughout the ages, enter your home and warm your hearth.
