


#### **Parking Barcode for January**

- Free parking is available in the parking garage east of Broadway on 12th Street. You will need a <u>barcode</u>. The barcode is available on slips of paper at the Cathedral and on our <u>website</u>. The barcode changes every month.
- 2. To enter the garage, using paper or your phone, turn the barcode toward the electronic reader to raise the arm. You will also use it to exit.
- 3. The same barcode can be used throughout the month.
- 4. If an attendant is on duty, show your barcode and explain you are going to the Cathedral.
- 5. If the garage fills up, you may be directed to a different garage.
- 6. If riding a bike, you may park it in the vestibule.



#### **GOD'S INTERPRETER**

Fourth Sunday in Ordinary Time Deuteronomy 18:15-20

God speaks to us in different ways because we do not always listen the same. We experience God in our communion at church, in the simplicity of nature, in the Sacred Scriptures, and in the counsel of the wise. But God often uses another person to bring a message to us, because we cannot hear it on our own.

During their exodus from Egypt, the chosen people heard the words of God through Moses. They liked it that way. They thought if they heard God's Word directly they would die. They needed an intermediary to shield them from the awesome power of God's presence.

God loved them and wanted them to hear the sacred words of the covenant. So God used Moses, and they listened to him.

God did even more for these people. God promised to give them another prophet from among their kin. God knew that in later generations we would have the same problem. We do not always listen to God the same. We need someone to help us interpret.

In the fullness of time, God raised up a prophet like Moses. Jesus sits at God's right hand and intercedes for us. Human and divine, Jesus helps us hear God's Word.
