## Are You Interested in Becoming Catholic?

---

The Cathedral of the Immaculate Conception welcomes individuals or families who are interested in joining our Catholic faith community.

### **Year-Round Catechesis**

Those who have already been baptized into another Christian community will prepare for reception into the Full Communion of the Catholic Church. The Rite of Reception will include Confirmation and First Communion. You may be received at any Sunday throughout the year after completing formation..

**FORMATION** We offer year-round formation. Participants attend Sunday Mass and regular formation sessions.

### **SEEKING BAPTISM**

Those who have not been baptized will prepare for baptism through the RCIA, process which includes the periods of Precatechumenate, Catechumenate, Purification and Enlightenment, and Mystagogy. Baptism takes place at the Easter Vigil.

### **HOW DO I START THE PROCESS?**

Whether you are baptized or unbaptized, the first step in this process is to fill out the RCIA Registration Form on our website, then I'll follow up with you to explain the rest of the process. [www.golddome.org](http://www.golddome.org).

### **WHAT IS RCIA?**

The Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults (RCIA) is modeled on the initiation ritual of the early Christian church. It is an experience of personal formation and spiritual growth which incorporates prayer, study, reflection, and discernment in a combination of public rituals and community preparations. It is the way unbaptized persons become Catholic.

**FORMATION** We offer year-round formation. Participants attend Sunday Mass, Breaking Open the Word, and regular formation sessions.

Breaking Open the Word takes place each week during Sunday Mass. During these sessions, you will discuss God's Word in the Sunday scripture readings and your personal journey of faith.

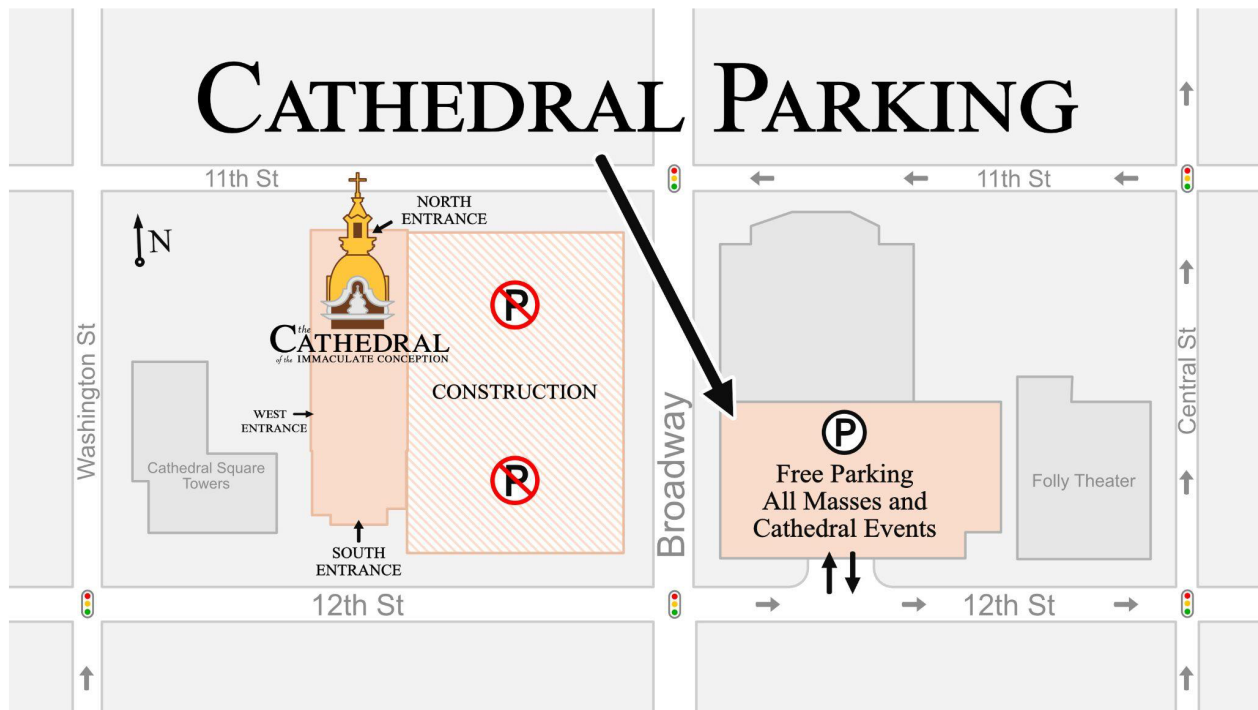

1. Free parking is available in the parking garage east of Broadway on 12th Street. You will need a [barcode](#). The barcode is available on slips of paper at the Cathedral and on our [website](#). The barcode changes every month.
2. To enter the garage, using paper or your phone, turn the barcode toward the electronic reader to raise the arm. You will also use it to exit.
3. The same barcode can be used throughout the month.
4. If an attendant is on duty, show your barcode and explain you are going to the Cathedral.
5. If the garage fills up, you may be directed to a different garage.
6. If riding a bike, you may park it in the vestibule.



## Overcoming Blunders

Third Sunday of Easter

Acts 3:13–15, 17–19

“Once in a while we make bad choices. Really bad choices. They make us feel like all is lost. What could make us feel better? We’d feel better if we knew that other people have made worse mistakes than we did and that they somehow overcame their bad choices.

Surely no one made worse choices than the people subjected to Peter’s sermon in Acts of the Apostles. Peter tells them God gave them Jesus, but they handed him over to Pilate and missed the opportunity to grant him freedom. They asked freedom for a murderer instead.

God overcame this blunder with the mightiest act in history: God raised Jesus from the dead. Peter and others witnessed the Risen Jesus.

Peter’s audience had made some really bad choices. They had the chance to spare Jesus from death, but instead they were responsible for it.

All was not lost. “Repent and be converted,” Peter told them, “that your sins may be wiped away.” And look who’s talking—a man who denied Jesus three times and who said, “I love you,” three times.

We have the same opportunity whenever we make bad choices. We can repent and change our ways. The God who raised Jesus has the power to forgive us. God can raise us up from despair to hope.

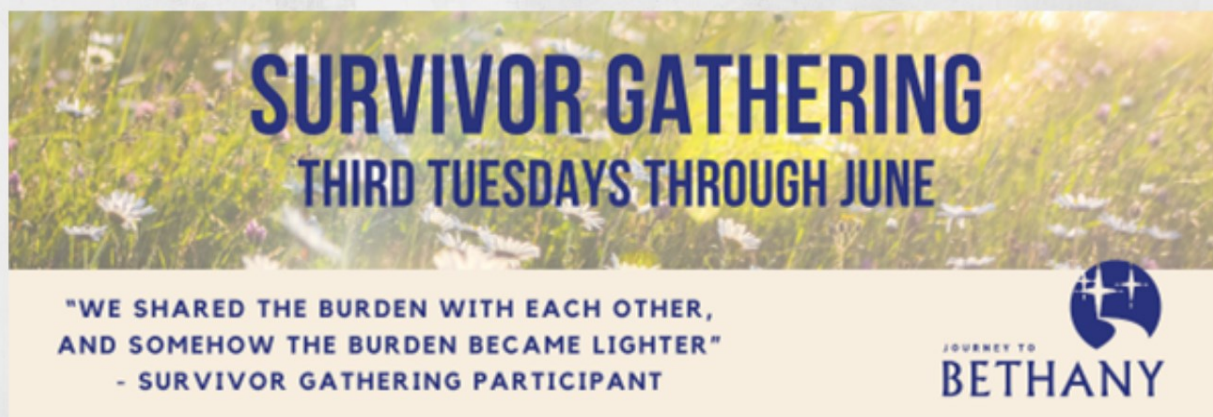
